Elam, trustee, his interests in his farm near Franklin, containing 126 acres more or less bounded by the lands of H. C. Rawls, J. H. Edwards, Jno. Puttar Jr., and the Black Water River - his present stock of goods, wares & merchandise of every description, including his interest in his crops and those of his tenants & his bonds, notes & open accounts in trust to secure the payment of two notes due by said Starfleet to the Commercial Bank of Suffolk - each of even date with this deed - one for \$350 - at 60 days and one for \$550 at 90 days - And it is specially agreed by the parties hereto that whatsoever goods may be bought by said Starfleet in regular course of trade shall be subject to this lien as long as it may remain in force. It is further agreed that should a sale be necessary by virtue hereof, it shall be upon 30 days ^{written} notice of time & place - and upon such terms as the beneficiary hereunder may desire, and in such event the trustee shall be entitled to the usual commission of five percent on gross sales. It is further specially agreed by the parties hereto that the notes herein secured shall be subject to curtail - and if new notes are taken by way of renewal or otherwise they shall have the place of the notes herein secured - and are fully intended to be secured hereby.
