 Norfleck to the Commercial Bank of Suffolk - each of
 even date with this deed - one for \$350 - at 60 days and
 one for \$550. at 90 days - And it is specially agreed by
 the parties hereto that whatsoever goods may be bought by
 said Norfleck in regular course of trade shall be sub-
 ject to this lien as long as it may remain in force.
 It is further agreed that should it ^{prove} necessary by
 virtue hereof, it shall be upon 30 days notice of time &
 place - and upon such terms as the beneficiary here-
 under may desire, and in such event the trustee shall
 be entitled to the usual commission of five percent
 on gross sales. It is further specially agreed by the
 parties hereto that the notes herein secured shall be sub-
 ject to curtail - and if new notes are taken by way of
 removal or otherwise they shall have the place of the
 notes herein secured - and are fully intended to be
