

This Deed of Bargain and Sale, made this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of Sept  
1879, between George E. Morris of the one part and Rachael  
Hardy of the other part, all of the County of Southampton, and State  
of Virginia, witnesseth, That for and in Consideration of the sum of  
Thirty dollars in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-  
edged, do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Rachael  
Hardy a certain piece of Land lying at Slaggy Run in the  
County of Southampton, and State aforesaid, and bounded by the  
Lands of Wm. C. Morris, George E. Morris and others, commencing at a pine  
tree in the Wm. C. Morris line at the road leading from Germanton, to Franklin,  
about along said road to a fence, thence in a northerly direction to a  
Stile, a corner in Mr. Oliver Edwards property, thence westerly along the  
line of the said Edwards property to a B.B. Purvis line, thence in a  
westerly direction along J. B. Purvis line to the beginning, and  
supposed to contain three acres, to the same more or less, to her and  
her heirs forever. The right and title to said land I warrant  
quietly. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand,

of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, grantor,  
of the first part and J. P. Beaman of the same County &  
State, chosen as Trustee, of the second part, witnesseth, that  
the said F. Debordinares doth grant and convey unto the  
said J. P. Beaman, the following personal property to wit, to  
his, the said F. Debordinares entire crop of Cotton, Corn,  
and Peanuts raised on his farm on which he now  
resides, in the County of Southampton and State of  
Virginia, consisting of 12 Acres in Cotton 40, in Corn and  
20 in Peanuts or so much thereof as may be necessary  
to be delivered at the store of C. H. Jenkins & Sons, Franklin  
Virginia on or before the first day of November next, and
