Beamor shall have the aforesaid mentioned right to sell on the premises, all of which is conveyed in trust, to secure the following debt to wit: one Note dated June 2^d 1879, and due and payable on demand, by the said Debordinate of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars and payable to W. H. Jenkins & Co, or order, and in default of payment of said Note, the Trustee shall sell any or all of said crops herein conveyed, and pay the same from proceeds of such sale.
