Whereas by trust deed dated 9<sup>th</sup> September 1879 and  
of record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton  
Jno. F. McClenney did convey & grant unto Mathew  
Gardner, trustee, a certain lot or parcel of land,  
situated in the town of Franklin supposed to contain  
one one fourth acre, & bounded North by Seaton  
& Roanoke Rail Road East by lands of Mary  
M. Barrett South by lands of Chas. Smith's coal  
by Rail Road track which runs from the Depot to  
Steamboat Wharf, in trust to secure the pay-  
ment of a bond of even date with the aforesaid trust  
deed, for three thousand nine hundred & Ninety  
five & Seventy five cents, due by Jno. F. McClenney  
to James McClenney and whereas the said bond  
has been satisfied as is evidenced by said Jno.  
McClenny becoming a party to this deed signing  
& sealing the same; And the said Jno. F. McClenney  
is now entitled to a conveyance of the aforesaid  
property free of & discharged from the lien of the  
aforesaid trust deed - Now therefore this deed of  
Release made this 13<sup>th</sup> day of October 1879,  
between Mathew Gardner trustee and James McClenney  
parties of one part, and Jno. F. McClenney of second  
part - witnesseth that in consideration of the  
aforesaid premises, the said parties of the first  
part do grants convey the before mentioned lot unto  
the said Jno. F. McClenney, free of and discharged  
from the lien of the aforesaid trust deed -
