This Deed, made this 18<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred twenty nine by then Sally Ann Pond of the first part, and H. P. Bradshaw of the second part; witnesseth that, in consideration of the sum of Forty (\$40.00) Dollars the said Sally Ann Pond doth grant unto the said H. P. Bradshaw with General Warranty, all of her undivided interest in a certain tract of land, it being the land formerly owned by William Shirley deed, and held by the said William Shirley to Sallie A. Pond during her natural life, and on her death to the said Sally Ann Pond & others, and bounded by the lands of Thos. Hobble, Elijah Brown, James Shirley, H. P. Bradshaw & others. The said Sally Ann Pond conveints that she has the right to convey the said land to the grantee, that she has done no act to encumber the said land, that the grantee shall have quiet possession of the said land, free from all encumbrances, and that Sally Ann Pond party of the first part, will execute such further assurances of the said land as may be requisite.
