Holland grantee of the second part, both of Southampton County, Virginia, witnesses, that for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred (\$400.00) Dollars this day paid by the said A. A. Holland and the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the said Jacob Dinow, the said Jacob Dinow doth bargain and sell, grant and convey with general warranty unto the said A. A. Holland, his heirs, assigns &c, the following property to wit: 1/4 of an acre of land with shops and appurtenances thereto belonging, situated upon the farm now owned and occupied by the said A. A. Holland, it being the same 1/4 of an acre retained in a Deed made to said Holland by said Dinow dated 11th Nov. 1875, recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton Co. The said
