Same. This agreement made & entered into this 1st day of
 April 1879 between S. O. Holt of the first part and
 Richard Preston of the second part, Witnesseth: For the
 consideration of Twenty one thousand (21,000) good hard
 birch cypress shingles to be delivered at Cypress Bridge
 in said County on or before the 1st day of Nov. next or in
 lieu thereof, the party of second part must pay to the
 party of the first part one & twenty dollars (20⁰⁰). The
 party of the first part promises and agrees to make to
 the party of the second part a Deed of Bargain & Sale
 of one certain tract of Land owned by said party of
 first part, lying in the Indian Woods & bounded by the
 land of Mrs. Lamb, James Brigg's estate & others. Now if the
 party of second part fails to deliver said shingles
