Boykin Depot Va. June 1st 1879.

I have this day bought of Moses & Seddon of
Norfolk Va Two thousand pounds (One Ton) of the
Paldwin Ammoniated Dissolved Bones, for which
I promise and agree to pay and deliver to them,
this authorized agent or legal representative or
on before the first day of November 1879, at Boykin
Depot Va. Four hundred and fifty pounds of
Clear White Lint Cotton not below the grade of
Middling, and of the first picking, put up in
bales weighing not less than four hundred pounds;
and it is further agreed and fully understood that
in case I should fail to deliver said Cotton
by that time, and the price of Cotton is lower on
the day I deliver it than on the day it was due
(Nov. 1st. 1879) I hereby agree to pay the difference
as also to pay the difference in grade, should the
Cotton I ship be inferior to the grade required
in this Contract. For the faithful performance of
this Contract I hereby constitute this a lien on
so much of my crop of Cotton, Corn &c., as may be
required to fulfill this obligation, as provided
in Chapter 310, of the acts of General Assembly of
Virginia, of 1870. In witness whereof I hereunto
