Know all men by these presents that I Albriston  
Edwards of the County of Southampton and State of  
Virginia, being a householder and head of a family  
do claim under an act of the General Assembly  
of Virginia approved June 24<sup>th</sup> 1870, prescribing  
in what manner and under what conditions  
a householder or head of a family may set apart  
a Homestead & personal property exempt from sale  
for debt, the following personal property to be  
held by me free and exempt from long Seizure or  
Sale for the benefit of myself and my wife Martha  
to wit, Five hundred bushels of peanuts valued  
at four-hundred dollars, sixty barrels of corn  
valued at two-hundred dollars, fifteen head  
of hogs and sixteen pigs valued at fifty dollars.  
The value of the property above specified not  
exceeding the sum of two thousand dollars  
(\$2000<sup>00</sup>) but valued at (\$650<sup>00</sup>) dollars.
