

This Deed made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of October in  
 the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and  
 Seventy Nine, between Richardson Whitley,  
 now of the County of Hartford & State of North  
 Carolina of the first party and Goodwin A. Cutt,  
 citizen of the County of Southampton & State  
 of Virginia of the other party; Witneseth that for and  
 in consideration of the sum of Fifteen (\$15.00)  
 Dollars in hand paid to the said Richardson  
 Whitley by the said Goodwin A. Cutt, the receipt  
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted  
 bargained & sold unto the said Goodwin A. Cutt  
 his entire interest in a certain tract of land  
 on which John Harrell died seized & possessed  
 lying in the County of Southampton & State  
 of Virginia, containing 53 1/2 acres more or less  
 bounded by the lands of G. D. Beaton & Joel West,  
 it being an interest said Richardson Whitley  
 heird from his son Ammanias Whitley Deed to  
 him and to his heirs forever and the said Rich-  
 ardson Whitley by these presents doth warrant  
 and defend the said interest in and to the above  
 described tract of Land hereby conveyed.  
 I, witness whereof, he has hereunto set his  
 hand and seal this day and year above written  
 Richardson Whitley
