Whereas Louisa J. Lenoir and Jacob Lenoir of the County of Southampton State of Virginia, grantors of the first part did the 1st day of October 1878 consequents Luther R. Edwards of the same County and State for the purpose of receiving the payment of a certain debt to wit: one bond bearing even date with said conveyance and due unto Jethro Cobb or order said debt being named and described in said Conveyance; a certain lot or parcel of land lying in the Town of Franklin and bounded as follows on the west by High Street, on the north by Fourth Avenue, on the east by a line extending from Fourth Avenue in a Southerly direction one hundred & five feet from and parallel with High Street (the eastern boundary of said Street) two hundred and ten (210) feet to Third Avenue and on the South by Third Avenue, containing by estimation one half acre by survey, it being known and designated on the map of Franklin as Lots No. 42 & 43 and whereas the said debt a Bond due unto the said Jethro Cobb has been fully paid by the said Louisa J. Lenoir & Jacob Lenoir by whom it was made and due. Now therefore this deed made the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November 1879, between the said Luther R. Edwards, Trustee aforesaid, and the said Louisa J. Lenoir the wife of Jacob Lenoir witnesseth that the said Luther R. Edwards does in consideration of the premises forever remise and release unto the said Louisa J. Lenoir the above mentioned lot or parcel of land lying in the said Town of Franklin & bounded by High Street 11<sup>th</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenues &c. and containing by estimation 1/2 acre by survey, and known on the map of Franklin as Lots No. 42 & 43 - the said land to be held by the said Louisa J. Lenoir as her exclusive and individual property free from all debts or contracts of her husband Jacob Lenoir. And the said Jethro Cobb gives his assent to this conveyance by signing this deed. Reference is hereby made to the deed of Bargain & Sale bearing date the 1st day of October 1878 from Jethro Cobb unto the said Louisa J. Lenoir for the above mentioned parcel of
