 one thousand eight hundred and seventy  
 nine, between J. F. Little of the County of Nanse-  
 mon, and State of Virginia, of the one part, and  
 George H. Nursey chosen as trustee for the  
 purposes herein named, of the other part.  
 Witnesseth: That the said J. F. Little doth grant  
 with general warranty, unto the said George  
 H. Nursey, trustee as aforesaid, the following  
 property, to wit: Six Cooking Stoves and fixtures  
 valued at \$150. Ten Heating Stoves valued at \$120.  
 A complete Stock of Tin Ware and metals  
 valued at \$400. A Stock of Camp goods valued at  
 \$40. A Stock of Tools and Machines valued  
 at \$100. All of which said property is now  
 placed and stored in the business house of  
 the said J. F. Little at Franklin, Southampton  
 County, Virginia, together with all and singular  
 the appurtenances belonging to the same.  
 In Trust to secure to Alexander Steeter of the  
 County of Norfolk in the State of Virginia  
 the payment of the sum of \$800. evidenced  
 by bond of record date with this Deed, and

 and it is covenanted and agreed between the
