This deed made this 29th day of November 1879 between Anthony Vaughan of the County of Southampton State of Virginia and John W. Lawrence of the same County and State chosen a Trustee of the other part, witnesseth that in order to secure the payment of one bond due Bartlett Tomlinson for the part purchase price of a certain parcel or tract of land, by the said Anthony Vaughan, he the said Anthony Vaughan doth grant and convey in trust to the said Gardner the following personal property to wit: One bay horse, sixty barrels of Corn (the entire crop of the said Vaughan this year) & twenty hogs to secure the above mentioned bond due by the said Vaughan unto the said Tomlinson, said bond bearing date the 3rd day of October 1879, and due with interest from January 1st 1880, the 1st day of January 1881, and should the said Vaughan make default in payment of said bond when due, then the said Trustee shall sell the above mentioned property for cash, and apply the proceeds according to law.
