 This Deed made the 25th day of November in
 the year 1879, betwixt Frank B. Jayner & Caroline
 his wife of the one part, and A. W. Norfleet of the
 other part witnesseth: that the said Frank B. Jay-
 ner & Caroline his wife do grant unto the said
 A. W. Norfleet a certain Lot in the town of Franklin
 bounded as follows: beginning at a point on the
 North side of 2nd Avenue & on the East side of & one
 hundred & twenty five feet from Garden Street,
 thence along 2nd Avenue in an easterly direction
 42 1/2 feet, thence in an northerly direction along
 a straight line parallel with Garden Street to
 3rd Avenue thence along 3rd Avenue in a westerly
 direction 42 1/2 feet, thence along a straight line
 in a southerly direction & parallel with Garden
 Street to 2nd Avenue the point of beginning estimated
 to contain a little less than one fifth (1/5) of an
 acre more or less, also a tract of land lying
 in Southampton County & on the New Road
 running from the old Jerusalem Road at a
 point near Jayner's Church to Jerusalem over
