I, the undersigned commissioners appointed at the September Term of said Court to lay off and assign to the widow of William R. Horrell deceased, Two hundred & one acre of land on which the residence is situated, and bounded as follows: Beginning at the point where the Rose Branch crossed the mill path at the Mineral Spring, thence along the same by the back gate, and continuing the mill Path to the other boundary line, thence along said line to a corner pine, thence a straight line (marked) to the Road near No. Ropes, thence S. Eight line to Alley's Corner, thence Alley's line to the Swamp; thence down Swamp to the beginning;
