

To the Honorable Judge of the County Court, Southampton.

We, the undersigned commissioners, appointed at the September Term of said Court to lay off and assign to the widow of William R. Worrell dec'd. one third (1/3) of all the Real Estate of which the said William R. Worrell died, seized and possessed, beg leave to make the following report.

After ascertaining by valuation the entire value of the whole real Estate and improvements, we allot to Margaret Worrell the widow of the said William R. Worrell dec'd. Two hundred & one acres of land on which the residence is situated, and bounded as follows. Beginning at the point where the Rose branch crosses the mill path at the Mineral Spring, thence along the line by the back gates and continuing the mill path to the other boundary line, thence along said line to a corner pine; thence a straight line (marked) to the Road near Mr. Pope's, thence S. Knight's line to Alley's Corner, thence Alley's line to the Swamp; thence down Swamp to the beginning.
