This Deed made this 12<sup>th</sup> day of December 1877  
between Jethro Cobb, E. P. Council and Sarah E.  
his wife of the County of Southampton, State of  
Virginia, grantor of the first part and Mathew  
H. Moore of the same County and State grantee  
of the second part witnesseth that in considera-  
tion of the sum of Four hundred and twenty  
five dollars to them paid the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged, they the said Cobb, E. P.  
Council and Sarah E. his wife do grant, bargain  
sell and convey with general warranty deeds  
the said Mathew H. Moore the following  
real property to wit: a certain parcel of land  
lying in the Town of Franklin in said  
County of Southampton, and bounded as follows  
commencing at the north corner of Main Street  
& Fourth Avenue thence in a north westerly  
direction along the entire boundary of Main  
Street two hundred & ten (210) feet to Fifth Avenue  
thence along the southern boundary of Fifth Avenue  
in an easterly direction Fifty five & one half (55 1/2)  
feet thence in a south westerly direction along  
a line parallel with Main Street Two hundred &  
ten (210) feet to Fourth Avenue; thence along Fourth  
Avenue in a westerly direction (55 1/2) feet to Main  
Street the point of beginning, containing by  
estimation one fourth (1/4) acre more or less it  
being the lot known on the map of Franklin  
as lot no 64 and which was assigned to Jethro  
Cobb by Commissioners appointed by the Circuit  
Court of said County of Southampton to divide  
allot and assign the lands in the said Town  
of Franklin belonging to John Bretton Jr and  
Jethro & Henry Cobb. And the said parties  
do bind themselves to make all further  
assurances necessary to convey unto the said  
Moore an indisputable and quiet possession
