This agreement made and entered into
this the tenth day of January eighteen hundred and
eighty between Lubbert L. Barren of
Southampton County and State of Virginia
of the one part and Peter Deloatch of same
County and State of the other part witnesseth
as follows: that whereas the said L. L. Barren
did at the September term of the County
Court of the aforesaid County buy a parcel
of land which formerly belonged to Ben
B. Kindred deed containing fifty acres
by the same more or less bounded by
the lands of W. J. Deloatch, Jas. M. Corbin
and N. T. Ridley - it being the land
which Henry Kindred dealt - gave by deed
to the Jno. J. Kindred, which was a part of
the tract of land called the Philips Tract
situated and lying about one and a
quarter miles south of Boykins Depot, Virginia
Now the said L. L. Barren agrees and
binds himself by these presents to sell and
deed the above described land to the said
Peter Deloatch with general warranty whenever
the said Deloatch shall pay him the said
Barren the sum of one hundred and
seventy five dollars as follows: fifty
eight dollars and thirty three cents due
before the first day of March 1880, fifty eight
