Excerpt

This agreement made and entered
into this 99th day of January 1880 between
Harrison Chambliss of the first part and
Grant of the other part both of the
County of Southampton & State of Virginia
Witnesseth: as follows, that whereas the
said Grant is about to engage in the
cultivation of the soil and is desirous
to obtain supplies during the year 1880
from the said Harrison Chambliss for the sum
of Two Hundred & forty five Dollars beyond
which sum the said Grant shall not go
and the said Harrison Chambliss having
agreed to furnish said supplies
Now the said Grant on his part
and in consideration of the above promised
doth grant a Lien to the said Chambliss
on all the crops which may be made
during the year 1880 upon the Land of ^{farm}
which the said Grant cultivates for the
