This Agreement made and entered into this the 19th day of January 1880 between Vaughan & Brother of the first part and Harrison Chambliss of the other both of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia, Witnesseth as follows that whereas the said Chambliss is about to engage in the cultivation of the Soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1880 from the said Vaughan & Bro and the said Vaughan & Bro. having already furnished said Chambliss with a Horse valued at ninety five Dollars to cultivate said Soil and the said Chambliss wishing more supplies of Money & Merchandise to the amt. of Two Hundred & forty five Dollars beyond which the said Chambliss shall not go, the said Vaughan & Bro. having agreed to furnish said supplies & Horse now the said Harrison Chambliss on his part and in consideration of said Horse & supplies doth grant a Lien to the said Vaughan & Bro. on said Horse and on all the crops, he the said Chambliss may make during the year 1880 upon the Lands of which the said Chambliss cultivates for the amt. of said Horse & supplies.
