To wit: one parcel of land about two miles from Boykins Depot It being the same that the party of the first part purchased at Public Sale, December 13th 1879 sold by Wm. M. Beaton Adm. with the will annexed of Edwin Harris deceased - said parcel of land contains by estimation one hundred & fifty five acs. be the same more or less - and bounded by the lands of J. G. Powell Mills C. Britts deceased, and Edwin Harris deceased.
