24th day of December A.D. 1879, between Jack Kindred
of Southampton County, Grantor, of the first
part and Henry B. Kindred Trustee of the
second part Witness as follows, that for
in consideration of the sum of One hundred
dollars due by note to Samuel B. Drewry
which will appear below, of the said Jack
Kindred do grant bargain and sell and
these presents convey unto Henry B. Kindred
Trustee, a certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in Southampton County
containing Eighty one acres more or less
and bounded by the lands of Dennis Boy
the heirs of James Gray decd. & others it
being the land which the said Samuel
B. Drewry has this day sold unto the said
Jack Kindred which is described by
Deed bearing the same date with this
