This Deed made and entered into this the 24th day of December A. D. 1879 between Jack Kindred of Southampton County, grantor, of the first part and Henry B. Kindred Trustee of the second part witness as follows: That for consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars due by note to Samuel B. Drewry which will appear below, I the said Jack Kindred do grant bargain and sell unto the presentee convey unto Henry B. Kindred Trustee, a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Southampton County containing Eighty one acres more or less and bounded by the lands of David Byrd the heir of James Gray deed. Whereas it being the land which the said Samuel B. Drewry has this day sold unto the said Jack Kindred which is described by deed bearing the same date with this
