Powell & wife grantors as aforesaid, doth grant bargain sell and by these presents doth deliver and convey unto the said Joshua H. Powell this Theobald Francis farm containing three hundred acres more or less and bounded on the North by the lands of J. W. M. Sykes on the South by the lands of L. G. Powell - on the East by the lands of L. G. Powell and on the West by the lands of Henry L. Smith. The land intended to be conveyed by this deed contains the whole of the said Theobald Francis farm with the exception of about fifty acres. The said fifty acres being cut off by a line which we have agreed on and which cannot be traced in this deed. To have and to hold the above described land to him the said Joshua H. Powell his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to his and their use forever. The said Littleton G. Powell doth covenant with the said Joshua H. Powell that he has a free and absolute right to the said land and that he conveys the same right and title to the said Joshua H. Powell in and to the said Theobald Francis land.
