1880 to the amount of twenty five dollars and  
whereas John W. Pepon of said County is  
willing and has agreed to furnish him to  
an amount not exceeding said sum of  
Seventy five dollars. Now therefore this agree-  
ment made and entered into this 17<sup>th</sup> day of  
January 1880. Witnesseth. That said Billy  
Newsom does hereby give and grant to  
said John W. Pepon a Lien on all crops  
grown by him said Newsom in 1880, to  
secure the advances aforesaid as provided  
in Chap. 363 of a special act of the General  
Assembly of 1872. To secure advances  
the said Newsom hereby further agrees to  
deliver to said Pepon as soon as practicable  
so much of said crops as may be sufficient  
to pay for the advances aforesaid.
