of the soil and desires advances during
1880 to the amount of seventy five dollars and
whereas John N. Puford of said County is
willing and has agreed to furnish him to
an amount not exceeding said sum of
seventy five dollars. Now therefore this agree-
ment made and entered into this 17th day of
January 1880. Witnesseth, That said Billy
Newson does hereby give and grant to
said John N. Puford a lien on all crops
grown by him said Newson in 1880, to
secure the advances aforesaid as provided
in Chap. 363 of a special act of the General
Assembly of 1872-3 to secure advances.
The said Newson hereby further agrees to
deliver to said Puford as soon as practicable
so much of said crops as may be sufficient
to pay for the advances aforesaid.
