This Agreement made and entered into this 24th day Jan^y A. D. 1880. Between R. B. Smith & J. A. Smith of the first part and R. F. Barham & John J. Turner of the second part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Witnesseth that the said R. B. Smith & J. A. Smith of the first part do this day bargain and sell to said Barham & Turner of the second part all of the pine & Cypress Timber now standing upon the Land known as the Brown Tract recently purchased of Messrs. J. D. Pillow & Bro. and what Timber he has already cut and delivered at their Saw Mill and what has been cut and not delivered they to take it where it now lies for the sum of one thousand dollars five hundred dollars Cash and one hundred dollars at the end of each year for the period of five years from this date, and it is further agreed that Barham & Turner have the privilege of ten years to cut and remove the Timber off of the Land before mentioned. Barham & Turner agree farther to use every reasonable exertion to saw the timber up as fast as they can get it to their Saw Mill, the said Smiths agree farther that if there is not eight hundred and twenty thousand feet of timber
