Waller and the said Lawson Beale thence along said Wallers line to a corner in George E. Beaton's line, thence down the line between said Beaton and Beale to a pine tree, which is the corner of said Beaton & wife's line, Lawson Beale and the heirs of John Whitehead dead, containing two hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less. It being the land which the said Lawson Beale and wife sold to M. F. Dill & Co. To have and to hold the said land to the said Beale & wife use forever, so that neither ~~David~~ nor any person for me shall lay claim to the above land
