Whereas my trust deed made May 3rd 1879
 and of record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton
 A. W. Norfleet did convey to J. B. Prince, trustee,
 all his stock of goods and personal Estate
 of every description in trust to secure a
 note due the Commercial Bank of Suffolk
 by Luther R. Edwards, upon which A. W.
 Norfleet is endorser dated 28th Apr: 1879,
 and also a note due by A. W. Norfleet to
 James Vaughan for about \$300- and whereas
 the whole of the ^{note} said notes has been fully
 paid, as is evidenced by the said Commer-
