This Deed of Bargain & Sale made this 31st day
 of January 1880. Between A. W. Norfleet and
 Indiana V. his wife of one part and the
 Seaboard & Roanoke Rail Road Company
 of the second part witnesseth. That in con-
 sideration of the sum of seven thousand
 five hundred dollars, recpt. of which is
 hereby acknowledged, the said parties of
 the first part do hereby grant & convey with
 general warranty unto the Seaboard and
 Roanoke Rail Road Company the
 following tract of land, together with
 all its appurtenances and appendages
 thereunto in anywise belonging, to wit, a
 certain tract of land situated in South-
 ampton County on the Black Water River
 near Franklin, the boundaries of which
 said land are as follow: by actual survey
 to wit: beginning at a post on South
 side of South Duby Road and near the
 run of a branch thence S. 46 1/2 E. 11.50 chains
 to a post with two pines in same line
 mark f. a. thence S. 4.50 ch. - to cypress f. a.
 thence S. 28 E. 1.27 ch. - to cypress f. a. thence S.
 38 E. 2.32 ch to cypress f. a. thence S. 4 1/2 W.
 3.30 ch. to cypress f. a. thence S. 10 1/2 E. 14.42
 ch to black gum in John Pretlow's line
 thence along John Pretlow's line to Black
 Water River, this line is more fully ind-
 icated by plot hereto annexed as a part
 of this deed. thence up Black Water River
 at low water mark to an old stone situa-
 ted at tide water mark of Black Water River
 seven poles and five links south of a
 large cypress standing at tide water of
 said River, thence S. 66 W. Seven poles and
 six links to the west side of the County
 Road at new corner of this tract and Simon
 Murfee in Richard Barrett's line, thence
 S. 33 E. Six poles and fourteen links
