This deed made this 14th day of February 1880 between C. B. Vaughan and Antonette his wife and J. P. Gay and Emma H. his wife of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia grantors of the first part and Elisha Bradshaw of the same County and State grantee of the second part witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, they the said parties of the first part do grant bargain, sell and convey with general warranty unto the said Bradshaw party of the second part the following tract or parcel of land lying and situated in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit: on the north by the lands of John Ellis, John M. Cobb and the land of the said C. B. Vaughan & J. P. Gay, on the West by the Cedar Swamp East by the lands of John Ellis and Carr Beale, and on the South by the South Quay and Smith ferry road, containing by estimation 275 acres more or less it being a part of the farm known as the Charles
