Whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court of Southampton entered at the Nov. Term 1878 in the Chancery Suit therin depending Stiles Powell & others v Jones &c. J. B. Prince was appointed a special Commissioner to sell the land of which James Powell died seized and whereas at the sale thereof E. L. Prince Commr as aforesaid does grant & convey with Special warranty unto the said E. L. Deltt 139  $\frac{1}{4}$  acres being the same more or less, the same being that portion of the Powell tract on west side of Blunt Swamp and bounded by the lands of David Driscoll's estate, Pt. J. Francis & the Blunt Swamp. Witness the following signatures & seal.
