This deed made the nineteenth day of February in the year eighteen hundred & seventy nine between Matthew Wells & Richenda L. Wells his wife of the first part & William W. Wells of the second part Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars paid by the said William W. Wells to the said Matthew Wells, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Matthew Wells & Richenda L. Wells his wife do grant unto the said William W. Wells all their right title & interest in that certain tract or parcel of land on which Matthew Wells the father of the above named Matthew Wells lived at the time of his death & on which Mary Ann Wells now lives, It being the
