1880, between M. M. Clayton, (Commissioner) of
the one part and Fanny Stephenson of the
other part all of the County of Southampton
State of Virginia. Witnesseth: that in consideration
of the sum of Six hundred Dollars (\$600⁰⁰)
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the
said M. M. Clayton (Commissioner) do grant
unto the said Fanny Stephenson all right title
and interest in a certain tract or parcel of
land known as "Holdens" containing one
hundred and twenty acres and a half, with
Special warranty, and bounded as follows:
on the North by Round Hill Swamp, on the
South by the lands of Murfie Hedgeboth, on
the East by the lands of R. H. Clayton on the
West by the lands of George W. Raiford - the said
M. M. Clayton (Commissioner) covenants that he
has the right to convey the said land, that he
has done no act to encumber the same, and
that he will execute such other deed as may
be requisite, if desired. In testimony whereof, the
