This agreement made and entered into this the 24th day of Jan: 1880. between J. E. Bailey of the first part and Solomon P. Ridley of the second part Witnesseth as follows, that whereas the said Bailey is or about to engage in the cultivation of the said land and is desirous to obtain supplies, fertilizers &c during the year 1880, from the said J. E. Bailey for the amount of Two hundred Dollars and twenty cents. And the said Bailey having agreed to furnish the said supplies, now the said Ridley on his part and in consideration of the above advances and promises does hereby grant unto the said Bailey a Lien on all the crops that may be made during the year 1880, upon the lands that the said Ridley cultivates for the amount of the above advances and cost of this Agreement. It is furthermore agreed by the parties to this Agreement that the said crops shall be delivered unto the said Bailey on or before the first day of Nov. 1880, and that no part of said crops shall be sold unless it is by and through the said Bailey, until this Agreement is satisfied.
