Whereas Jas. S. Hubbard of Southampton County
 is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and
 desired to obtain during the year 1880, advances
 and supplies to the amount of one hundred and
 fifty dollars, and whereas P. S. Thomas of said
 County does hereby agree to furnish him to an
 amount not exceeding the said sum of one
 hundred and fifty dollars, Now therefore this
 Agreement made and entered into this 25th
 day of January 1880 between said Thomas and
 the said Hubbard witnesseth, That the said
 Hubbard does hereby give and grant to the
 said Thomas a lien on all crops, grown by
 the said Hubbard in 1880, to secure payment
 for the advances aforesaid, as provided in
 Chap. 363 of an act of the General Assembly of
