Whereas Curtis Gilliam of Southampton County  
is engaged in the cultivation of the soil, and it does  
now to obtain during the year 1880, advances in  
supplies, to the amount of Two hundred dollars  
and whereas P. S. Thomas of said County does  
hereby agree to furnish him to an amount not  
exceeding the said sum of Two hundred  
dollars, now therefore this agreement, made  
this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of January 1880, between the said  
Gilliam and the said Thomas, Witnesseth  
that the said Gilliam does hereby give and  
grant to the said Thomas a lien on all crops  
which may be grown by the said Gilliam  
in 1880, to secure payment for the advances aforesaid  
as provided in Chap. 363 of act of the  
general assembly of 1872-3 &c. The said Gilliam  
agrees to deliver to the said Thomas or his  
order as soon as possible after said crops or  
any part thereof shall have been severed,  
so much of said crops as may at first, or  
from time to time be sufficient to pay for  
the advances aforesaid. Witness our signatures
