This Deed, made this 14th day of February A.D. 1880,
between Frederica J. Parker, of Southampton County
of the one part, and Romine E. Sebrill, of South-
ampton County, of the other part. Witnesseth, that the
said Frederica J. Parker, for and in consideration
of the sum of Five Hundred and one Dollars to
her in hand paid, at and before the sealing and
delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged, doth grant bargain,
sell, release and confirm, with general
warranty, to the said Romine E. Sebrill, and her
heirs and assigns forever, all of that certain
lot or parcel of land lying in the county of
Southampton and village of Jerusalem, and
containing by estimation three quarters ($\frac{3}{4}$)
of an acre, be the same however, so much more
or less, and bounded as follows, to wit, By Main
Street in Jerusalem, By Street leading from said
Main Street perpendicularly to Nottoway River,
and by said Nottoway River, and the lot or
parcel of land formerly sold by the said
Frederica J. Parker to the said Romine E. Sebrill
the said land herein conveyed being the same
on which the said Frederica J. Parker lately
resided, and includes with the land hereto-
fore sold, to the said Romine E. Sebrill, the
