Witnesseth that in as much as said Stark Mason is engaged in Agriculture and desires advances and supplies to an amount not exceeding Thirty dollars and also $\frac{1}{2}$ ton Allison & Addison's Star Brand manure and whereas the said J. H. & J. B. Prince are willing and have agreed to furnish said Stark Mason to an amount not exceeding Thirty dollars. Now therefore the said Stark Mason gives & grants a Liens upon his crops of cotton, loom & fodder to secure said debt. The manure to be paid for with 213 lbs. bale cotton grade middling & to be delivered at Bellfield by Nov 1. 1880. The said Stark Mason also gives a Liens upon one steer, one bull and - hog.
