and also one ton Allison & Addison Star Brand
Manure and whereas the said J. H. & J. B. Prince
are willing and have agreed to furnish said
Willis Manning to an amount not exceeding
Twenty five dollars and also one ton A & A's
manure, Now therefore the said Willis Man-
ning hereby gives and grants a lien upon
his crops of Cotton, Corn & fodder to be
made in 1880. The manure to be paid for with
Bale cotton to weigh 425 lbs. grade middling
and be delivered at Bellfield by Nov: 1. 1880.
