H. & J. B. Prince are willing & have agreed to furnish said Richard Ridley to an amount not exceeding Sixty dollars and also one ton of A. & A's manure. Now therefore the said Richard Ridley gives and grants a Lien upon his crops of Cotton, Corn & other to be made this year. The manure to be paid for with bale cotton to weigh 425 lbs per ton & delivered at Bellfield by Nov. 1. 1880. The said Richard Ridley also gives a lien upon one mare to secure this debt.
