H. & J. P. Prince are willing & have agreed to furnish said Collier Coland to an amount not exceeding Fifty dollars and also $\frac{1}{2}$ ton A. & A. Star brand Manure. Now therefore the said Collier Coland hereby gives & grants a lien upon all his crops Cotton, Corn & fodder to be made during the year 1880.
