H. & J. P. Prince are willing & have agreed to furnish said Collin Glaud to an amount not exceeding Fifty dollars and also $\frac{1}{2}$ ton A. & A. Star brand manure. Now therefore the said Collin Glaud hereby gives & grants a lien upon all his crops Cotton, corn & fodder to be made during the year 1880. The manure to be paid for with one bale cotton to weigh 420 lbs for a ton to grade middling & delivered at Bellfield by Nov. 1. 1880, and the said Collin Glaud also gives a lien upon two oxen.
