Hart is engaged in Agriculture, and desires advances & supplies to an amount not exceeding One hundred dollars, also one & half tons Allison & Addison's Star brand manure, and whereas the said J. H. & J. B. Prince are willing & have agreed to furnish said E. J. Hart to an amount not exceeding one hundred dollars and also 1½ tons A. & A's Star brand manure now therefore the said E. J. Hart hereby gives and grants a lien upon all his crop, Cotton, Corn, fodder, grown during the year 1880, either by himself or any tenant or tenants cultivating his lands, or some or thereof as it will take to satisfy said debt. The manure to be paid for with one & ½ bales cotton to weigh 425 lbs. Grade middling and delivered at Bellfield Feby 28th 1880. Witness the following signatures
