 willing & have agreed to furnish said E. J. Hart
 to an amount not exceeding one hundred doll-
 ars and also 1 1/2 tons A. & A's Star brand manure
 now therefore the said E. J. Hart hereby gives and
 grants a lien upon all his crops, Cotton, Corn
 & fodder, grown during the year 1880. either by
 himself or any tenant or tenants cultivating
 his lands or so much thereof as it will take to
 satisfy said debt. The manure to be paid
 for with one 1/2 bales cotton to weigh 425 lbs.
 grade middling and delivered at Bellfield
