also two and half tons Allison & Addison's
"Star Brand Manure" and whereas the said
J. B. & J. B. Prince are willing and have agreed
to furnish said Tom Tennessee to an amount
not exceeding two hundred & fifty dollars
and also two & half tons of A & A Star Brand
Manure. Now therefore the said Tom Tennessee
hereby gives and grants a lien to said J. B. &
J. B. Prince upon all his crops Cotton, Corn,
& fodder or so much thereof as it will take
to satisfy the said debt. The "Manure" to be
paid for with two & half bales Cotton seed
to weigh 425 lbs: grade middling to be
delivered at Pellfield by 1st Nov. next. And
the said Tom Tennessee also gives a lien
