This agreement made this 28 Feby. 1880 between John Banks and J. H. & J. B. Prince Witnesseth that in as much as said John Banks is engaged in Agriculture and desires advances and supplies to an amount not exceeding Eighty dollars and also $\frac{7}{10}$ ton Allison & Addison's Star brand manure and whereas the said J. H. & J. B. Prince are willing and have agreed to furnish said John Banks to an amount not exceeding Eighty dollars and $\frac{7}{10}$ ton H. & A's Star brand manure, The said manure to be paid for with $\frac{7}{10}$ bale cotton to weigh 425 lbs. grade middling & delivered at Billfield by Nov. 1880. Now therefore the said John Banks gives & grants a Lien upon his crops, cotton, corn & fodder to be made 1880 to secure the debt above mentioned and also the manure. The said John Banks also gives a lien upon one mule, Witness the following signatures
