 Fielding Davis col. grantee of the other part,
 resident of Southampton County Virginia. Witness
 That for and in consideration of the sum of
 one hundred Dollars this day paid and the
 receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the
 said parties of the first part do bargain and
 sell grant and convey with Lymenal warranty
 to the said Fielding Davis and his heirs forever
 the following real estate to wit: A certain
 tract or parcel of land lying and situate in Berlin
 2nd Ebor District in the County aforesaid, conta-
 ining 67 acres more or less, and bounded by
 the Indian Branch, and the lands belonging
 to the Est. of Dr^r Benj. E. Cobb decd. The said land
 formerly belonged to Joseph Drenny, deceased,
 who was the grand father of the said Mary
