This Deed made this 16th day of June 1879 between
 Mary E. Wren & Sallie L. her Daughter grantors of
 the first part, residents of Petersburg Virginia and
 Fiddling Davis sol. grantee of the other part,
 resident of Southampton County Virginia. Witness
 That for and in consideration of the sum of
 one hundred Dollars this day paid and the
 receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the
 said parties of the first part do bargain and
 sell grant and convey with general warranty
 to the said Fiddling Davis and his heirs forever
 the following real estate to wit: A certain
 tract or parcel of land lying and situate in Berlin
 2nd & 3rd District in the County aforesaid, conta-
 ining 57 acres more or less, and bounded by
 the Indian Branch, and the lands belonging
 to the Est. of Dr. Benj. E. Cobb died. The said land
 formerly belonged to Joseph Drewry, deceased,
 who was the grandfather of the said Mary
